In accordance with Infrastructure items which can be provided or maintained, the Parish Council undertook replacement of Play Equipment in Pinder Park during Oct 2020 which had come to the end of its life, under the Power to acquire land for recreation grounds; public walks; pleasure grounds and open space; and **to manage and control them**. The Total net Cost of the Play Equipment was £8,700 of which, all £8,165.40 CIL money was applied to the work undertaken by Caloo Ltd.
