1. Apologies:

- Sue Kyle, Murial Arden, Ed Knox – apologise due to holiday or personal commitments.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting

Accepting minutes from previous meeting.

3. Matters arising (excluding updates to the Plan document, see below).

- All of the sites that are now in and with Luke to be mapped.
- Public consultation and engagement with local businesses. We will be having a meeting in Rampton on 29th September and a date yet to be fixed for Woodbeck.
- Rampton Hospital maps – some are in public and some are confidential for 100years from 2010. Mike is seeking permission to access the confidential maps.
- Ed will be getting leaflets printed.
- Luke – submitted sustainable development information for the report.
- Website is still a work in progress and will be live in mid-August.

4. Future of the District Council.

- Rumour that Nottinghamshire County Council are looking to abolish the district councils. The leader of Bassetlaw DC has said that he is not keen on this, and there has yet to be a vote.

5. Equitable distribution of any financial benefits from new housing developments.

- Mike raised that if most of the sites that have been submitted are in Woodbeck, that any CIL payments should then spent in reflection of this.

6. Public consultation in September

- Contents e.g. explanatory text, maps, diagrams etc.
- Materials e.g. display boards, signs etc.
- Advertising the event.

- ii. Advertise with leaflets being put round to all the houses, little signs down the roadside, and ask the school if they may send a text message to parents.
- iii. Staffing – Mike is available on Saturday 29th September. 10:30-12 set up time, then 12-4pm for drop in session.
- iv. Luke to put together a presentation that we can deliver to the audience before having an informal Q&A.
- v. We need to get feedback from people who come so that we can analyse what people feel

7. Feedback on funding.

- Lottery money was applied for but they fed back to say that the argument wasn't strong enough. However, we have resubmitted and we have been informally told that our re-submission should be granted.
- Locality funding has been received.

8. Feedback from landowners.

Received and will be included in the maps Luke is producing.

9. Updates to the Plan document.

- Luke suggests adding a section on green architecture, plus historical significance of the link between Rampton and Torksey.
- Will suggests that Rampton is quite different in that it is nucleated and not linear like many of the other villages within Bassetlaw.
- Darren Carroll may also be coming before the consultation event and so some of this information may be added to the presentation.
