Background

Councillor Arden gave the background to why this meeting had been called.

Last Friday she and Councillor Doyle met Karen Tarburton to get advice about various council matters which require funding. Village Hall needs were discussed and decided we could go to Awards for All for the Village Hall for grants.

Karen is part of the East Midlands team which we understand is to merge with Lincolnshire to make a larger division which would then make it much harder to get money in the future. She advised us to get in an application for the park as soon as possible. The next application date is 8th July, We agreed that I would get the material together and she would come next week to fill in the forms. We could use the Awards for All application and voluntary work as part of our contribution but there is the matter of Third Party Funding. Because the application deadline is before the next Parish Council meeting I have called an extra ordinary meeting. Although there has been agreement in principle that some funds would be available, the decision needs formal approval given by the Parish Council. In the past there has been a signed document from the chairman. This money would only be taken if the bid was successful and the community would have £50,000 benefit for a cost of a little over £5,000. The decision date is not until late November so the Chair felt justified in accepting this help from Karen Tarburton.

Pinder Park application for Grants

Need to discuss the third party funding, if the application is successful we will be getting approximately £50, 000 for a third party funding of £5300. We have already done a lot of voluntary work on the field and put a lot of money into developing it for the Community. We are looking for a piece equipment that would benefit most people which it has been decided after consultation with the Community on a MUGA (Multi User Games Area), a ramp and Zip wire. This application to WREN would be for the M U G A. An Application had been made to Awards for All for the Multi play unit.

Street scape was one of the best and we have a quote for just under £50, 000 plus VAT.

There was a discussion about the various grants and applications. The Village Hall Committee were applying through Awards For All for a grant for the Village Hall needs.

Rampton Parish Council

This application for Pinder Park would be done through the Parish Council with Karen Tarburton's help.

The Proposal:

The Chair to have the authority to sign this application which includes agreeing the third party funding on behalf of the Parish Council. Councillor Morris added that Councillor Hawkins be able to counter sign.
